Notice of Public Hearing
Town of Sweden

The Town of Sweden will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, May 11 at 6:45 pm** at the Sweden Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, NY 14420 for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Town of Sweden's Community Development Block Grant (CDB) CARES Act application, "Senior Room Addition to Address Social Distancing, Ventilation and Sanitation," for the 2021 program year.

The CDBG CARES Act program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and the Town of Sweden is seeking \$500,000 for public facilities with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG CARES Act program and will allow for citizen participation in the development of the proposed grant application for a Senior Room Addition and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternate proposals. Comments on the CDBG CARES Act program and proposed project will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

The Sweden Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport is accessible to persons with disabilities.
