

At 7:00 p.m. Supervisor Johnson called to order a public hearing located at the Sweden Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on March 13, 2018. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons interested in the establishment of a sewer district extension to the Fourth Section Road North Side Sewer District.

Town Board Members present were Supervisor Kevin G. Johnson, Councilperson Robert Muesebeck, Councilperson Patricia Hayles, Councilperson Mary Rich and Councilperson Lori Skoog. Also present were Finance Director Leisa Strabel, Town Architect David Strabel, Town Attorney Jim Bell, Town Clerk Karen Sweeting and Superintendent of Highways Brian Ingraham.

Visitors present were Brockport Village Trustee Annie Crane, Joan Hamlin, Christine Hamlin, Don Grentzinger, Susan Smith and Wayne Zyra.

Supervisor Johnson asked Town Clerk Karen Sweeting to read the legal notice published in the Town's official newspaper. Notice read.

Supervisor Johnson asked if anyone had any comments. Resident Joan Hamlin stated that she does not live in the sewer district, but felt the residents were getting an amazing deal with the addition of the property to the district. Supervisor Johnson added that it would be a financial savings for those already in the district. He said he realizes that some residents opposed the rezoning, but hopes that this agreement, at least in a small way, will improve the effects of the rezoning and help all the residents in the sewer district with the related costs.
