Supervisor Milner asked if anyone had any comments.

Shawn Lessord from Evanhee Clean Energy introduced himself and stated he has installed several wind towers and also assisted Clarkson with their local law. Discussion.

Resident Tim Bates read a prepared statement and provided a copy to the clerk. Mr. Bates felt that the issues brought up at the first public hearing (September 14, 2010) were still a concern.

There were no other comments. The public hearing was closed at 7:15 p.m.
