

PUBLIC HEARING

November 26, 2002

At 7:04 P.M. Supervisor Lester called to order a public hearing at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on November 26, 2002. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons in favor of or against the Fire Protection Contract for the year 2003.

At 7:04 PM Supervisor Lester called the Public Hearing to order. The Town Clerk read the legal notice of the hearing.

Supervisor Lester gave the figures that each municipality pays towards the budget. There will be no tax for ambulance service because third party billing will pay for it.

Councilperson Carges said that the Town is fortunate that the Town of Clarkson helped and aided in the "crisis" that occurred. The municipalities still have to deal with the dispatcher issue and the formation of a fire district.
