Mr. Hale asked if the property to the east was a filed subdivision. Mrs. Savard wasn't sure. Discussion followed. Mr. Minor stated that due to how long the parcel has been around, it probably has not been before the Board for subdivision approval.

Mr. Minor requested the agricultural statement be added to the plans.

Lot 5, Campbell Road

Mr. Giannotti and the excavating contractor addressed the Board informally to discuss flipping the driveway from the east, low side to the west, high side. The Building Inspector had referred Mr. Giannotti to the Planning Board. The main reason for the change is because the driveway is blocking the septic system on the low side.

Mr. Hale asked if they had encountered any farm tiles? Mr. Giannotti responded nothing has been done to the site to date. Discussion took place regarding thoroughly testing for farm tiles.

Mr. Giannotti asked for direction in order to get the change approved. Mr. Hale stated an amended site plan should be filed, which includes completing an application and submitting a mylar.

Mr. Oberst asked where would the water service be located. The excavating contractor stated either side; possibly the other side would be better.
