

At 7:00 p.m. Supervisor Lester called to order a public hearing located at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on December 13, 2005. The purpose of the public hearing was for consideration of petitions submitted by Carl Lana, in Trust for Josephine and Rose Lana to extend and/or establish Special Districts in an area known as The Shoppes at Owens Landing in the Town of Sweden. The petitions under consideration are to extend the Sweden Consolidated Sewer District, to extend the Sweden Consolidated Water District, and to establish/extend a Drainage District.

Town Board Members present were Supervisor Lester, Councilperson Carges, Councilperson Connors, Councilperson Ferris, and Councilperson Windus-Cook. Also present were Town Clerk Karen Sweeting, Town Historian Kathleen Goetz, and Zoning Board of Appeals Chairperson Don Grentzinger.

Visitor present was Jim Hamlin from 50 Park Avenue.

Supervisor Lester asked Town Clerk Karen Sweeting to read the legal notice published in the Town newspapers. Notice was read.

Supervisor Lester stated that the formation of the three district extensions, water, sewer, and drainage is a cost solely borne by the developer. This location is the proposed Lowe's.

Supervisor Lester asked if there were any comments. No comments were made. The public hearing was closed at 7:15 pm.
