

At 7:20 p.m. Deputy Supervisor Rob Carges called to order a public hearing located at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on December 27, 2007. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons for or against the adoption of Local Law 4 of 2007 – Addition of “Stormwater Management and Control” to the Sweden Town Code. Articles within this chapter to include: “Design and Management of Post-Construction Stormwater Pollution Prevention Measures”, “Construction Site Stormwater Pollution Prevention and Erosion and Sediment Control”, and “Illicit Discharge Connection Stormwater”.

Town Board Members present were Deputy Supervisor Rob Carges, Councilperson Patricia Connors, Councilperson Tom Ferris, and Councilperson Danielle Windus-Cook. Supervisor Buddy Lester was absent. Also present were Finance Director Leisa Strabel, Town Clerk Karen Sweeting, Town Attorney Jim Bell, Director of Buildings and Grounds Jeremy Oakden and Superintendent of Highways Fred Perrine.

Resident Jim Hamlin was present.

Deputy Supervisor Carges waived the reading of the notice due to low number turnout.

Town Attorney Jim Bell said attorneys of Harris Beach prepared the text of this local law as a model for the County of Monroe. Mr. Bell stated that this local law would supersede any current provisions in the Sweden Town Code. When adopted, the Town will be responsible for the enforcement of any stormwater violations.

Deputy Supervisor Carges asked if there were any comments. No comments were made. The public hearing was closed at 7:30 pm.
