The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons for or against the adoption of Local Law 1 of 2007 – proposed amendments to Local Law 5 of 2005 and Sweden Town Code Chapter 164, Section 1 – Aged Exemptions. The amendments include but are not limited to raising the income limitations for qualified persons aged 65 years or over for real property tax exemptions to \$34,400.
