## Patriot Landing Extension Subdivision and Site Plan. Sweden Lane.

Mr. Philip Miglioratti addressed the Board. He gave a brief overview of the proposed development.

Mr. Miglioratti stated he changed two issues which came up at the informal meeting. There is now enough room for the proper swing of a large fire truck to enter. The roadway is 24 ft. wide. Per Mr. Monno's suggestion, the garages were pushed back so that there is a 10 ft. area in addition to the 24 ft. width. Residents will now have room to see when backing out.

Mr. Strabel also noticed a hammerhead was added to the turnaround. He questioned whether the ingress/egress to Lake Road would be paved. Mr. Miglioratti wasn't sure yet, only that it would be stoned for now, depending on the cost of paving.

Mr. Monno questioned page 3 (b) of the PIF. It should be corrected with the amount of crushed stone being brought in.

Mr. Minor asked where the utilities tie in. Mr. Miglioratti stated water is coming from Lake Road, gas from Sweden Lane, sewer from the north and heads east, and electric is already on the property (new service will be underground).

Moved by Mr. Strabel, seconded by Mr. Hale, that the Patriot Landing Extension Subdivision and Site Plan be accepted for review.
