Councilperson Ferris reported that he had met with three individuals to discuss a disc golf course at the Sweden Town Park. A tentative course had been mapped out and turned over to

David Scott, Recreation Director. Mr. Ferris stated that the three individuals would be attending the next workshop to present the idea of the disc golf course to the Board. Mr. Ferris told the Board that the project could be completed by June for a small investment and little maintenance. The course will maximize a lot of the unusable space and rough terrain at the Town Park.

Councilperson Windus-Cook met with a landscaper to discuss possible solutions to the Town Park entrance. Vehicles have been going around the gate to illegally enter the park and causing damage to the lawn areas. Ms. Windus-Cook suggested a number of solutions using standard landscaping materials.
