

At 7:15 p.m. Supervisor Lester called to order a public hearing located at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on June 28, 2005. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons for or against the relocation of Advantage Machine, LLC located at 1900 Transit Way, Brockport, New York into the Rochester Economic Development Zone.

Town Board Members present were Supervisor Buddy Lester, Councilperson Rob Carges, Councilperson Patricia Connors, and Councilperson Danielle Windus-Cook. Councilperson Tom Ferris was absent. Also present were Finance Director Leisa Strabel, Building Inspector Bill Weber, Town Clerk Karen Sweeting, and Highway Superintendent Fred Perrine.

Visitors present were Attorney Richard Olson from 24 West Avenue in Spencerport, Michael and Sean McLean, Charles Wester from Advantage Machine, LLC, and Jim Hamlin from 50 Park Avenue.

Supervisor Lester asked Town Clerk Karen Sweeting to read the legal notice published in the Town newspapers. Notice was read.

Supervisor Lester then asked Charles Wester from Advantage Machine, LLC if he wanted to make any comments. Mr. Wester stated the reason for the relocation was due to lower utility costs and moving to an Economic Development Zone would benefit each employee.

Supervisor Lester stated that the public hearing was just a formality, and then asked if anyone would like to place a comment on the record. There were none. Mr. Lester thanked the visitors for attending the meeting. The public hearing was closed at 7:30 pm.
