The meeting started at 4:40 p.m. on Thursday, July 29, 2004, in the West Conference Room at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York. The following were in attendance: John Brugger, Jerry Foster, David Hale, and Marleen Cain, Clerk.

Following the last meeting, it was determined that Connect-A-Ride no longer exists. Page 6-21, number 22 will be deleted. Also, in section E, page 6-21, number 19 will be amended and the page included as a part of these minutes.

Section F was started and review completed. The changes will be done and the pages made a part of these minutes. Mr. Brugger volunteered to determine what open space is left within the Village to see if it is possible to remove the Village from the issues regarding open space. Superintendent of Highways Perrine will be asked about the existence of and need for maintenance standards for facilities and equipment as mentioned in number 5 on page 6-26.

Mr. Foster raised the issue of a limit on building size in the town. There was a lot of discussion. He also raised the issue of protecting the escarpment and developing a linear park along the whole escarpment in the Town and not just in the part that the Town owns (the Community Center and Cemetery). He will prepare a rewrite for consideration at the next meeting.

The next meeting will be on Thursday, August 19, 2004, at 4:30 p.m. Chapter 6 has been reviewed. Mr. Hale asked about reviewing and possibly revising the maps in the Plan. Bergmann Associates completed the maps for us in 2002. The questions to the Town Board are can we revise at this time? How? And by whom?

The meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
