

At 7:13 p.m., Deputy Supervisor Carges called to order a public hearing at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York, on August 24, 2004. The purpose of the public hearing was to review the application from Iroquois Rock Products, Inc. to renew their Excavation Permit in the Town of Sweden

Town Board members present were Deputy Supervisor Carges, Councilperson Connors, Councilperson Ferris, and Councilperson Windus-Cook. Also present were Building Inspector Bill Weber, Finance Director Leisa Strabel, and Deputy Town Clerk Marleen Cain.
