The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons for or against the adoption of Local Law 3 of 2007 – amendment to Local Law 3 of 2006 Section 170-31 Schedule V: Stop Intersections. The amendment includes the placement of a stop sign at the intersection of Goldenhill Lane and Long Point Lane in Phase 1 of Northview Subdivision in the Town of Sweden.
