Transit Way Subdivision. Transit Way. 084.01-1-1.005.

Mr. Schultz presented a proposal on behalf of clients purchasing a portion of property owned by Mr. Daniel Hogan. The parcel in question is located on the south side of Transit Way and includes a 60 ft. right-of-way (ROW) to Transit Way. The project leaves an additional lot that conforms to commercial zoning requirements. There is potential for one or two future lots on the north side of Transit Way. The lot on the south side is under contract for engineering of a multi-family residential development.

Chairperson McAllister confirmed that Wood Trace is a dedicated road and will continue through the proposed lot on the south side, connecting to the 60 ft. ROW.

Clarification was requested regarding a small additional lot created on the south side. Mr. Schultz explained that Monroe County regulations no longer allow properties to cross a dedicated road, resulting in the need to create a separate lot on the north side. The small lot on the south side is the remaining portion of the larger parcel being subdivided.

Chairperson McAllister inquired about the land to the west of the parcel. Mr. Schultz clarified that this land is not owned by Mr. Hogan, but by Brockport NCP, LLC. The Board discussed surrounding features, including a mound of dirt and wooded areas. It was determined that the dirt mound is located on the Sporting Dog's property.

Mr. Schultz stated that a total of three lots are being created in the proposed Transit Way Subdivision.
