At 7:00 p.m. Supervisor Milner called to order a public hearing located at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on August 4, 2009. The purpose of the public hearing was to consider the petitions of Michael McLean, owner of Heritage Square Subdivision and the UC Brockport Housing, LLC, owner of College Suites at Brockport, to extend and/or establish Special Districts in an area known as Heritage Square Subdivision in the Town of Sweden. Petitions to be considered are extensions to the Sweden Consolidated Sewer and Water Districts, extension to the Sweden Drainage District and establishment of a Lighting District.

Town Board Members present were Supervisor John Milner, Councilperson Rob Carges, Councilperson Patricia Connors, Councilperson Tom Ferris and Councilperson Danielle Windus-Cook. Also present were Finance Director Leisa Strabel, Town Clerk Karen Sweeting and Superintendent of Highways Fred Perrine.

Visitors present were residents Terry and Cheryl Cooley and Caurie Putnam.

Supervisor Milner asked Town Clerk Karen Sweeting to read the legal notice published in the Town newspaper. Notice was read.

Supervisor Milner asked if anyone had any comments. Written comments were received from Terry and Cheryl Cooley relative to concerns with lighting. Terry Cooley expressed additional concerns with hours of operation at the site.

Finance Director Leisa Strabel explained that the formation of the Lighting District determines who pays for the utilities, in this case, the installation and usage costs for three light poles.

No further comments were made. The public hearing was closed at 7:15 pm.
