

At 7:15 P.M. Supervisor Lester called to order a public hearing at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on December 10, 2002. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons in favor of or against the adoption of Local Law No. 2-2002 – Amending Section 2(a) of Local Law No. 1 of 2000 Aged Exemption and Local Law No. 2 – 2002 – Amending Section 1 of Local law No. 2 of 2000 – Persons with Disabilities.

Present: Town of Sweden Supervisor Lester, Councilperson Carges, Councilperson Connors, and Councilperson Windus-Cook.

At 7:15PM Supervisor Lester called the Public Hearing to order. The Town Clerk read the legal notice of the hearing.

Supervisor Lester explained that the laws are in regards to exemptions for seniors and persons with disabilities. The income level is to be raised to \$21,500 from the previous \$20,500 established in 2000. The Brockport School District and the Village of Brockport also raise the limits to the same dollar amounts.

As there were no further questions to come before the Board, the Supervisor closed the Public Hearing at 7:30 PM.
