

At 6:30 p.m. Supervisor Johnson called to order a public hearing located at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on Tuesday, January 21, 2020. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons for or against the adoption of a Local Law – Amendments to Chapter 166 Telecommunication Facilities in the Sweden Town Code.

Town Board Members present were Supervisor Kevin G. Johnson, Councilperson Patricia Hayles, Councilperson Robert Muesebeck, Councilperson Randall Hoke and Councilperson Rhonda Humby. Also present were Finance Director Leisa Strabel, Town Attorney Jim Bell, Superintendent of Highways Brian Ingraham and Town Clerk Karen Sweeting.

Visitors present were Chris Hamlin, John Zima, Wayne Zyra, Julie and Frank Lapinski, Harold Polle, Don Grentzinger, Don Davis and Cindie Carnell. Others were present but did not sign in.

Supervisor Johnson waived the reading of the legal notice.

Town Attorney Jim Bell explained that the proposed local law revamps and replaces the current Chapter 166 in the Sweden Town Code which was adopted in 1997 and amended in 2006. The current law details requirements for large facilities. Many of the proposed updates involve small facilities.

Resident John Zima had questions pertaining to Section 166-6(E) Exceptions – satellite antenna diameter and Section 166-6(F) Exceptions – amateur receiver only facilities, should add transmitter. Most amateur radio operators receive and transmit, the code is limiting.

No other comments.

Supervisor Johnson closed the public hearing at 6:38 p.m.
