

At 7:00 P.M. Supervisor Lester called to order a public hearing at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on October 22, 2002. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons in favor of or against the construction of a telecommunications tower at 4927 Lake Road South.

At 7:00 PM Supervisor Lester called the Public Hearing to order. The Town Clerk read the legal notice of the hearing.

Supervisor Lester announced that the Community Center would be gifted to the town by the end of November. The proposed cellular tower would be constructed on land next to the building. Todd Philipp of Nextel said that lease arrangements with the Town have already been arranged for the community center site. The company needs coverage for in building at the route 19 and 31 intersection. Coverage is also needed for the SUNY Brockport campus. It is a 100' monopole to be inside a 60' by 80' chain link fence. Nextel has read the comments from the Town engineer, the Environmental Conservation Board, Planning Board and Consultant Bill Johnson. He feels the company has addressed concerns. A demolition bond will be provided upon completion of construction.

As there were no further questions to come before the Board, the Supervisor closed the Public Hearing at 7:15 PM.
