Councilperson Sullivan reported that activities at the Town Park are going well. Repairs were done to the little league fields. The adult leagues and Challenger Baseball are finished. The Ultimate Frisbee tournament took place. There is some new signage on the dugouts and outfield walls. There were some minor skate park issues. The Splash Park and Dog Park have been busy.

Councilperson Hayles reported the Seymour Library Budget presentation will be held on August 29, 2023 at 7 p.m. The library board reviewed the preliminary budget and will present several considerations. Harvest Festival planning continues. They need volunteers to help with the event and runners for the 5K. The big items are in place. The Farmers' Museum is planning more gardening classes and a barn tour.

Supervisor Johnson reported that the Gary Drive signals should be operational by the end of August. The Town Hall renovations are moving along. The first-floor abatement is complete. Staff will prepare to move back to the building in the next week or so, the Town Court will move first. The new town signs will be installed soon. Due to an accident, the Talamora Trail sign was damaged. Quotes for replacement were requested. The Board will need to consider several options once received. Mr. Johnson was made aware that a sex offender has moved into Sweden Village. The Town does not control where people live, the offender is only required to register. The Town has received several complaints relative to new development near Talamora Trail. The Building Department is working on resolving those issues.

Town Attorney Jim Bell received a commercial challenge to the tax assessment for CVS.
