

LAKEVIEW CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MONUMENTS AND MARKERS

TEMPORARY FUNERAL MARKERS

Temporary funeral markers are not the cemeteries responsibility, but are allowed on a grave until proper markers can be set.

Temporary funeral markers are exactly what they are called-**TEMPORARY**, and should be replaced by a proper marker within twelve months.

MONUMENTS AND MARKERS

Monuments and markers must be of natural granite or bronze.

Monuments and markers will be placed on foundation in the proper location, row, and facing the proper direction.

Flat Markers must be a minimum of 4" in thickness, and will be set ground level with grade or ground contour.

Length, width and height restrictions apply to monuments and markers. These restrictions vary depending on number of graves and their layout. See chart below.

FOUNDATIONS

All foundations to be constructed by cemetery staff or approved sub-contractor, and must be at least the size of monument or markers bottom or base dimensions.

Later add on bases to monuments or markers must have the proper foundation. No exceptions.

Monument and marker foundations must be completed and paid in full before delivered or set.

All settings or deliveries are to be done from cemetery roads during regular hours. Please be sure to stay off the grass.

LARGER MONUMENTS

Are only allowed on multi grave plots (3 graves or more). Final plans showing dimensions must have cemetery approval.

CROSSES, STATUES, SPECIAL MONUMENTS, MAUSOLEUMS, AND ASH BENCHES

Must submit sketch and dimensions for approval. Not all submissions will be approved. Any interments inside of monuments, mausoleums and ash benches will need to be scheduled in advance with submission of burial order and proper interment fees before remains are installed within the monument.

GOVERNMENT MARKERS

Flat granite only. **No uprights or marble.** Foundations must be paid for before stone will be set.

GOVERNMENT PLAQUES

Are to be mounted on monument or base stone only.

REMINDER:

ALL DELIVERIES OR WORK IS TO BE DONE FROM ROADWAYS. STAY OFF OF GRASS.
